## Journey to the Fatherless

- Journey to the Fatherless was used by WinShapeHomes (a foster care ministry of Chick-fil-A) for their leadership and parenting training in Atlanta, GA in May 2014.

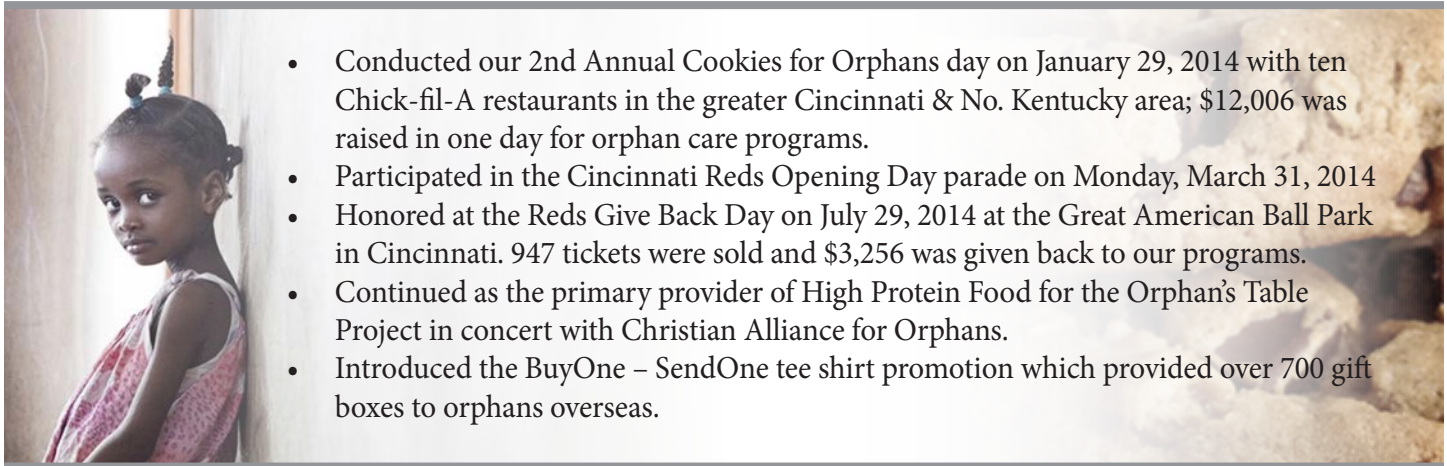
- Conducted twenty three Public, four Mobile, two Private and five 4T Special events producing over 15,915 Hope Boxes™ totaling 3,437,640 high protein meals.
- Hosted over 11,471 guests at either the Hope Factory™ or at one of our mobile sessions.
- Provided Hope Boxes™ to partners in El Salvador, Swaziland, Sierra Leone, Honduras, Zambia, South Sudan, Ukraine, Haiti and Appalachia during 2014.
- Partnered with RestoreHope and Caring Partners Int'l with Hope Boxes™ and medical kits for Ebola victims in Sierra Leone in September 2014.
- Provided 3.5 tons of High Protein Food for the Cincinnati Free Store Food Bank throughout December 2014.
- Partnered with the US Air Force Denton Program in June 2014 for our second airlift into Haiti. Additionally, we partnered with the Navy for delivery to El Salvador in August 2014.



- Increased our purchasing volume, in just one year, of the P&G Children's Safe Drinking Water sachets to enable our recipients to produce 1,525,144 gallons of clean drinking water.
- When purchased, each bottle of Clean Water for Orphans™ will provide 15 gallons of clean drinking water.



- Helped several families start and some continue the adoption and foster care process – many of them began as a result of the Hope Factory™ experience!
- Awarded \$18,365 financial grants from the A Child's Hope adoption and foster care fund to help orphans come home to their forever families.



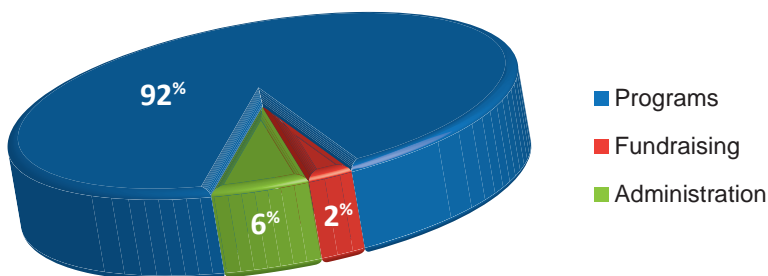
- Conducted our 2nd Annual Cookies for Orphans day on January 29, 2014 with ten Chick-fil-A restaurants in the greater Cincinnati & No. Kentucky area; \$12,006 was raised in one day for orphan care programs.
- Participated in the Cincinnati Reds Opening Day parade on Monday, March 31, 2014
- Honored at the Reds Give Back Day on July 29, 2014 at the Great American Ball Park in Cincinnati. 947 tickets were sold and \$3,256 was given back to our programs.
- Continued as the primary provider of High Protein Food for the Orphan's Table Project in concert with Christian Alliance for Orphans.
- Introduced the BuyOne – SendOne tee shirt promotion which provided over 700 gift boxes to orphans overseas.

- Completed a financial audit confirming that 92% of all donations were used for program expenses for orphans and vulnerable children.
- Renewed our accreditation with the Gold Star Exchange by Guidestar; less than 9% of evaluated non-profits are awarded the Gold Star level; as well with the Evangelical Council of Financial Accountability (ECFA) and the Better Business Bureau (BBB).
