O n July 12, 2023 we lost a champion for children in need when ACHI's co-founder, Elizabeth Bergeron, affectionately known as Liz, passed away. She is now at home, embraced by her beloved Lord and Savior, Jesus.

Liz shared her life with her loving husband and A Child's Hope Int'l co-founder, Larry Bergeron. Together they built a family bound by love and faith and dedicated their lives to caring for orphans and vulnerable children. Liz leaves behind a legacy of love through her devoted 7 children (2 adopted), and 14 cherished grandchildren.

However, their mission extended far beyond their home. Elizabeth was passionate about adoptive families receiving the support they needed to welcome children in and to attach as a family. She spent endless hours counseling parents and caring for their practical needs, even setting up a clothing bank where adoptive families could receive tangible, caring support.

Elizabeth's love and concern for vulnerable children knew no bounds. She was a faithful advocate for local families and her profound compassion for suffering children around the world leaves an immeasurable impact.

Elizabeth was a vital part of the creation of this mission to feed children in need so that they could survive and find hope in Jesus.

Her tireless committment resulted in over 58 million high protein meals and millions of gallons of clean water reaching the most vulnerable children worldwide, helping them thrive against all odds.

As a champion for children in desperate need, Elizabeth's caring influence and encouragement were felt by the Red Shirt Team members, who worked closely with A Child's Hope Int'l. Again and again, she embodied the call that the fatherless are worthy of our sacrificial service in order to insure they know Jesus' love through demonstrations of support.

Elizabeth's warm presence, unwavering faith, and deep love for her family left an indelible mark on all who knew her. We were grateful to be able to honor Elizabeth at our Founder's Day celebration on June 1 at the Hope Factory.

No one ever would have imagined that she would be gone a short time later.

Today, we continue in her footsteps as recipients of her legacy, a legacy that will forever inspire us to serve the most vulnerable, just as Elizabeth did.

Elizabeth lived out James 1:27, which speaks of caring for orphans and widows in their distress, with love and dedication.

Famine in the Horn of Africa

Missed rains, failed harvests, and hotter temperatures has led to food insecurity across the Horn of Africa. Somalia has been one of the hardest hit places. In January, A Child's Hope Int'l (ACHI) mobilized with a Christian partner (in a country 99% Muslim) to bring relief in Jesus' name through critically needed meals. So far in 2023, 570,240 high protein meals have been shipped to our partner in Somaliland and another 285,120 are scheduled to depart ACHI's warehouse by end of year.



Board Visit to Kenya

In June, Jerry Shannon (Exec. Dir), Doug Peters (ACHI Board Chairman), and Dr. Donald E. Jones (Board member) traveled to visit our long-term partner in Kenya, Bishop David. ACHI's assistance in funding sustainable agriculture has helped to feed children in Kenyan orphanages as well as generate revenue to support their other programs in serving children and families in the community.

Exciting New Collaborations

2023 was a year of expanded local collaborations including new relationships with area ministries. schools and community centers where we can serve side by side. ACHI's greatest collaborations that expanded in 2023 were with local food pantries and nutrition support organizations. Thorugh partnerships with 40 local food pantries, we distributed over \$3 million worth of donated food and household items back into our local community. Additionally. 50.000 Hands Against Hunger® meals were shared with the Freestore Food Bank and another 30,000 meals to other agencies.

In 2023, A Child's Hope Int'l assisted two local Ohio families struggling with significant trauma in their adoptive family situation to receive the counseling and parent coaching to help their families move toward thriving. Our Family Suport Grant exists to assist families with post-adoption needs, including trauma counseling, medical bills or other special needs.

Feeding Children in Haiti

As the situation in Haiti continues to worsen, the import of aid has grown increasingly difficult. In order to continue to provide daily meals to the 400+ children in school feeding programs, ACHI is providing \$2,000 in cash assistance every month for local food purchase. Additionally, meals have been shipped to the Dominican Republic to meet the needs of Haitians who have fled.

Mobile Event at Impact Church in MI

For the second year in a row, A Child's Hope Int'l has taken our Hands Against Hunger® meal packing event on the road to serve with Impact Church in Lowell, Michigan. Impact Church made a huge impact by packing 285,120 (one full shipping container) of high protein meals both in 2022 and 2023. Over 1,000 volunteers from the church and community converged over a weekend of 4 packing sessions to make a difference for children and families in Eswatini. This is a full-circle partnership as Impact Church has been serving with Adventures in Missions in Eswatini for years. Now, families in Michigan can pack the very meals that children in their Care Point will be eating.

Your support helped sustainable agriculture to create new opportunities for children living in children's homes. And importantly, you kept orphaned children in Haiti fed and cared for while their country is a war zone.





Nourishing Dreams in Eswatini

Meet Simanga, a 15 Year-Old with Big Dreams in Eswatini

In the heart of Eswatini, a small country in the center of South Africa, a story of hope is unfolding. It's a story of resilience, determination, and the profound impact of a simple meal.

Simanga, a 15 year-old, resides in the Richmond area of Eswatini. His journey, like many others in this community, has been far from easy. His mother passed away, and his father's whereabouts remain a mystery. Simanga and his 4 siblings live with his grandmother in a small homestead provided by a caring friend. Unable to find work, his grandmother faced the daunting

challenge of providing for her grandchildren with no income. It's difficult to

fathom the hardships this family faced. Their daily existence hung in the balance, with hunger often casting its shadow. But then a lifeline arrived in the form of a Hope Box®, provided by supporters like you.

The nutritious Hands Against Hunger® meals inside these Hope Boxes® became more than sustenance; they were a lifeline. With each meal, Simanga's family found the strength to face another day.

Hope Rises in Southern Ghana:

Transforming Lives One Village at a Time through Local Ghanaian Ministries

F or villagers in Southern Ghana, every day brings extreme hardships.

Trying to live a subsistence living in an area where there is no work, dirty water and no medical care leads to hunger, treatable disease and hopelessness taking their toll. Children cannot even attend school because the closest school is up to a 10 mile walk away.

However, because of the generosity of our donors, hope has arrived for 52,000 people living in villages where A Child's Hope Int'l is working alongside of our international partner, King James Foundation (KJF). Working alongside KJF, we are helping vulnerable children and families thrive by helping to meet their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs.

Limited access to healthcare, nutritious food, and economic opportunity often results in children being orphaned. Breaking the generational cycle of extreme poverty requires preventative Our intervention in Ghana is simple at heart. Yet sometimes it only takes simple interventions to make a huge difference.

work upstream. Since 2019, A Child's Hope Int'l has been working alongside KJF inside Ghana with community-led development programs that are meeting the needs of vulnerable children and strengthening families. Together, we have delivered high protein meals, improved access to clean water, brought medical care into rural villages, and built sanitation houses that have led to transformation in the communities.

In 2023, 46,000 patients were screened and treated by traveling nurses and a physician's assistant in these remote villages.

Children and individuals were screened for HIV, tuberculosis, malaria, waterborne diseases, and a whole host of other diseases. Blood pressure and diabetes checks are ongoing as hypertension and diabetes can otherwise cut lives short. Infections and malnourishment were treated and referrals were made to hospitals over an hour away for those in severe need.

When malaria hit hard, the medical team was there to treat and save lives. When skin infections and parasites were running rampant throughout the villages, nurses met the need. These simple interventions make a profound inpact.

Our intervention in Ghana is simple at heart. Yet sometimes it only takes simple interventions to make a huge difference. The simple task of bringing safe and

clean water to remote villages reduced typhoid occurrence by 50 percent, and nearly eliminated cholera. Both of these diseases take lives every day, yet because of your support, the lives of children, families and the elderly were

saved and they are now experiencing a new hope.

Pastor James and his staff are very visible in these villages. They are providing not only for physical needs, but also are meeting spiritual needs as they meet with those who are hurting, pray with them and share about the good news of Jesus.

While our focus is sustainability, there are times when there still is a need for an influx of relief again. Worldwide inflation, poor harvests and interruptions in supply due to the war in Ukraine led to extreme food insecurity in these already vulnerable villages in Ghana.

To meet the critical need for nutritious food, ACHI shipped a container of 285,120 Hands Against Hunger® meals to Ghana which were distributed to those most in need. A second container is expected to ship by year end.

As we look to 2024, our partners are leading us to expand our programs beyond food, water, medical care, and sanitation, to include economic empowerment and education.

Thank you for the part you play in bringing transformation to children and families living in forgotten villages off of remote dusty roads in Southern Ghana.

Empowering Girls in India: Clean Water, Safe Toilets



E arly in 2023, Pastor Paparao, our partner in India, reached out with a concern. Girls attending the schools his organization runs were facing an unsafe situation as they did not have private toilets to use. This was a hygiene concern, but it also was a safety concern since girls could easily be sexually assaulted without access to their own facility.

The plan was to renovate shipping containers (a commodity that we are very familiar with) to contain a private toilet block for the 300 girls attending the school. These toilet blocks have running water, tile floors, walls, and are easily connected to public sewer or septic.

With a plan in place we set out to fund one toilet block. However, God had different plans. We saw an outpouring of such generosity among our donors that we were able to supply four toilet blocks for four different schools that Mission to the Nations India runs.

You blessed these girls and young women in an amazing way by providing clean and safe toilets for them. In addition to the toilet blocks, more than 50 wells have been drilled in slums in India through your donations. Each well brings clean water to over 2,000 of the poorest of the poor who have no access to clean water otherwise.

It only takes \$1,100 to install a well in this region of India. If you are looking for a different kind of gift, please reach out and help provide clean water and hygiene which will change lives.



Is it food or is it medicine?

"If I had my way, I would change the name of Hands Against Hunger® to be called Miracle Food." James Solomon Mensah (Ghana partner)

W ith great excitement, James searched through his file folder saying, "You have to see these before and after photos. This food is miracle food."

The source of James' enthusiasm lay in the fact that he had just witnessed a doctor in Ghana experience the healing power of God found within Hands Against Hunger® meals. About 3 months prior, James met 4 young boys living in a rural community outside Accra, who were HIV+.

These boys were orphaned and alone, and their health was rapidly deteriorating. Despite the doctor's attempts to treat them with medicine, their condition continued to worsen, and their weight severely decreased as infections took over their bodies. The doctor was ready to give up hope that these boys would survive, but James remained resolute.

Moved by compassion and driven by an urgent desire to rescue these children from hopelessness, James made a promise to the doctor. He proposed that if the doctor allowed him to provide the boys with Hands Against Hunger® meals every day for 3 months, they would recover. The doctor, having exhausted all medical options, agreed, though he had little faith that anything more could be done to save the boys.

James carefully ground the meals, creating a nourishing porridge, and every day for 3 months, he sat with the boys and fed them. It didn't take long to witness a rekindling of hope. The boys began to regain their weight, their hair grew back, and the infections

started to subside. Baffled by the incredible transformation, the doctor approached James and asked, "What kind of medicine have you been giving these boys behind my back?"

James humbly replied, "I was not giving them any medicine, but rather I was giving them miracle food." The nutrition within these meals, coupled with the miraculous intervention of God, has brought about healing for these boys, leaving the doctor amazed and wondering how he could access these miracle meals for others in need.


